



MJF AWARDS

The Merimbula Jazz Festival Award is presented annually to someone who has contributed to the ongoing development and longevity of jazz music, in all its various forms, and the continuing patronage of jazz festivals.



In 2017 Jazz Festival President Kevin Walsh (right) presented the Award on behalf of the Committee to an outstanding musician in the person of Tony Buckley.

Bassist Tony Buckley was born in Sydney on 30 May 1937. He commenced formal music lessons at age ten on piano, discontinuing several years later and then restarting and intensifying training again at age 17 on double (string) bass. Development as a young musician embraced playing in student orchestras and theory training at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music.

During the 1950's and later, he worked and toured with several commercial entertainment units involving vocalists Frank Ifield, the late Bobby Scott and Johnny O'Keefe, the big dance Bands of the late Bob Gibson, the late Bill Barrett and the late Bobby Limb and Dawn Lake Club Band. Whilst in the midst of all this Tony also joined in a number of smaller dance bands and registered club floor show bands which utilized the services of most of Sydney's noted and up and

Pier One Bar and Grill (02) 64951101 coming jazz musicians (many who have since passed away). Tony also participated in the historic Kings Cross 'El Rocco Jazz Cellar' scene playing with several groups including the Warren Leroy trio, John Pochee and friends.

These connections led to Tony's overall interest and development playing jazz, and in the year 1965 he moved to Melbourne until 1969 where he linked up with Vibraphone player Keith Stevens. This in turn led to ensuing friendships with other Melbourne jazz players such as Alex Hutchinson, Alan Richards, Kim and Anita Harris, Graeme Steele, Ron Anderson, Neil Taylor and the late and great drummer David May. On returning to Sydney Tony worked the Registered Club circuit again with various jazz gigs here and there and in 1982 became associated with traditional jazz when joining the Nat Oliver Jazz Band led by Oliver Hetherington. Since then he has also played with most of Sydney's prominent musicians and jazz bands from time to time including Jiri Kripac's Harlem Swing, Mike Hallam's Hot 5 and Hot 6 and Bill Haesler's Robber's Dogs Jazz Band. Tony has also played in the company of many other notable Sydney musicians including Bob Barnard, Trevor Rippingale, Jack Wiard, Paul Furness, Jim Elliott, Paul Baker and the late Eric Holroyd just to name a few.

Some of Tony's most memorable music experiences have seen him playing some years back at 'Quad Cities', edging the Mississippi River in the USA, with a group of Sydney musicians including Jim Elliott, and the late Ken Flannery, Adrian Ford, Brett Lockyer and John Fearnley at the BIX Beiderbeck Memorial Jazz Festival and also backing the Mills Brothers vocal quartet and vocalists Vic Damone and Billy Daniels at the old Kings Cross Sydney Chevron Hotel. During his 63 years love affair with the bass Tony has been heavily influenced by many great overseas bassists such as the late Ray Brown, Red Mitchell, Neils Orsted, Henning Pederson as well as Ron Carter, George Mraz and Garry Peacock who are still playing to this day. So is world class Bruce Cale Tony's wonderful talented 'Aussie' bassist friend now located in Katoomba NSW.

It must be said that Tony's involvement with music, embracing most genres, including jazz, and attendance at numerous Jazz Festivals throughout Australia, including the long running Merimbula Jazz Festival, has been a lengthy one. At 80 years of age he is still playing, loving his music and importantly listening to the marvellous musicianship advances demonstrated by so many young and older players throughout the world.



ORBITUARY – FAREWELL MJF AWARD WINNER RUSS "RED RIMS" SHERIDAN

– 12/9/1934 – 13/6/2017 Russ "Red Rims" Sheridan was a welcomed and popular performer at the Merimbula Jazz Festival for many years. In 2009, he received the MJF Award for his commitment to our Festival.

Russ started piano lessons at the age of 5 and by 11 he was entertaining customers in his aunt's hotel in Geelong. He played up and down the iconic Surf Coast of Southern Victoria. He was part of the Owen Yateman Jazzmen that won New Faces.

The list of bands that he payed with is too long to name but Merimbula Jazz Festival audiences will remember him most for the Ragtime Rollers that was the group that played each year at the Jazz Breakfast and of course Pluck and Tickle. He was very much in demand in a range of bands at the Merimbula Jazz Festival over many years.

His last gig was on Monday 12th June at the Jazz Hatters Party where he played with Mal Quine in Mal's Malingerers. At the end of the set he left in high spirits with the words "See you tomorrow". But sadly that was not to be and Russ died suddenly early next morning.

We will miss him - a true gentleman and a great friend of the Merimbula Jazz Festival.

A SHORT HISTORY OF THE MERIMBULA JAZZ FESTIVAL.

"The Beginning"

It was during an impromptu Sunday afternoon gig in 1980 at Stan Delle Virgin's home at 20 Main Street Merimbula that the notion of a local Jazz Festival was mooted. The Gipps Dance Band headed by Margie Fullerton from Traralgon Vic were in town, and were relaxing on the Sunday after playing for a Golf Club Ball the previous night.

At this time the Local Down South Jazz Band were getting their act together and Stan invited them all for a blow. The Lounge Room photo above shows all those musos present, from left to right: Barry Pascoe, Trom - DSJB. Barry Turner, Bass - Gipps. Tony Fullerton, Trom -

Gipps. Ron Foale, Reeds - Gipps. Margie Fullerton - Gipps. John Cursley, Drms - DSJB. Jiri Kripac, Tpt - DSJB. John Hargreaves, Drms - Gipps. Phil Lowe, Drms - Gipps. Stan Delle Vergin, Bass -Host. Marj Fox, Tpt - Gipps. Bill McLean, Banjo - DSJB. Leon Cross, Reeds - Gipps.

Also present were locals, Pat and Lyn McGannon, Lee Cross, and Helen McDonald. Stan lived at Sale in Gippsland in the late 50s. He played danceband music with most Gippsland musicians, in particular, The Ron Foale Dixieland Jazz Band. The Merimbula Jazz Festival Award was originally named "The Ron Foale Award".

Local musos Barry Pascoe, John Cursley and John Moffat along with Stan, agreed that the idea was worth following up and those four became the first organising committee for the Merimbula Jazz Festival held in 1981. Barry Pascoe is recognised as the founding father and was the driving force. The Down South Jazz Band led by Jiri Kripac had formed and was practising regularly at the Wolumla Pub. The band registered for and attended the 35th Jazz Convention in December 1980.

Barry, John Cursley and the others spread the word to Convention musos and delegates and issued the very first MJF Newsletter and the registration forms. They publicised the fact that a founding Jazz Festival was to be held at Merimbula on the following June long weekend of 1981. Not many people in the jazz world knew where Merimbula was located, but that has since changed.

NEW BANDS AND SPECIAL PERFORMERS IN 2018

We are delighted to announce that among the visiting bands and performers this year are:

YOUNG JAZZ WORKSHOPPERS

The Young Jazz Workshoppers are a band of students from Jazz Workshop Australia, a venue and music school in St Leonards, Sydney. Aged 9 to 14, they are keen and talented. With a rare three-trumpet front line backed by a swinging rhythm section, they are led by their teacher and mentor, Saul Richardson, on electric bass. They look young but these kids can play!

THE MAGNIFICENCE

Trumpet player and singer Cam McCracken Smith has been honing his set of almost-traditional jazz and New Orleans inspired originals for over a decade, playing at Edinburgh Fringe, Woodford Folk Festival and every pub and street corner from Canberra to Cairns.

The legacy of Storeyville continues in the growing collection of Smith's witty, unpretentious songs that entertain and amuse. Formed in 2017 with Brother Lachi on Drums, for the Merimbula Jazz Festival they will be joined by Dave Abkiewicz on Sousaphone, John "the Bone Ranger " Gosling trombone, Tom Manley clarinet and Liam O'Connell on banjo.

The Magnificence growl, they mewl, they cook – and they make audiences feel better about otherwise questionable life choices.





CUL DE SAC

This popular band is led by the great saxophonist Ron Anderson, a winner of the Merimbula Jazz Festival Award, supported by long-time friend Graham Morris on drums. The band had a residency of some nine years at the Rising Sun Hotel in South Melbourne, which must be some sort of a record for a modern jazz quartet.

The band coined the name Cul De Sac during this period, to jokingly describe a band that "was going nowhere"! The opposite is the case as they continue to delight audiences as they explore music ranging from Brubeck to the Beatles. Regulars with the quartet are Todd Sidney on piano and Dave Taylor on bass.

SAXEMA

Saxema is a talented saxophone quartet from Canberra, which was formed in 1998 when a group of friends began meeting to make music together. Despite some changes in personnel the group is still going strong twenty years later. Saxema has performed at many venues throughout Canberra and surrounding areas and has also been featured live on local ABC radio.

Showcasing the versatility of the saxophone family, Saxema's repertoire covers a wide range of jazz styles from toe-tapping ragtime and early jazz to contemporary tunes. The individual voices of the soprano, alto, tenor and baritone saxes are all featured and blend together to make a sound that is truly unique!

On the back of a string of shows at Frankies By The Slice, Lazybones Lounge, Foundry616, Venue 505 and the Wollombi Music Festival, Pezcobar are about to hit the studio.

BRASS KNUCKLE BRASS BAND

Brass Knuckle Brass Band is a sweaty late-night party for anyone who knows a sousaphone will always be tougher than a bass guitar. Think whiskey dripping from trombone spit-valves; drummers with callouses on their callouses. Think a crusty bari sax belting from the gutter and you're starting to get the idea.

First thrown together for a one-off Wednesday night show, BKBB has opened for funk heavyweights Charles Bradley and Fred Wesley, and played at Falls Festival and Woodford Folk Festival. Following a debut EP in 2013, the band collaborated with hip-hop young gun Citizen Kay on the single "Raise a Glass", which became a Triple J favourite.

SAX HQ AND FRIENDS

Consisting of music students and staff at Bairnsdale Secondary College, SaxHQ is a constantly evolving group exploring the musical possibilities of the saxophone. This year they have joined forces with

Robbie Mann is a self-taught Ragtime and Stride piano specialist based in Canberra, with background in Classical piano. His group, 'Robbie Rags The Classics' continues the tradition of adapting various popular melodies into the jazz idiom, commonplace among the enterprising ragtime and jazz pianists, dance bands and orchestras of old. Indeed, the popularity of ragtime and jazz was due in part to how amenable the style was in applying to all kinds of melodies. Robbie has gone a few steps further than the usual token efforts and has adapted

a wide range of composers - ranging from Bach, Mozart, Beethoven through to Chopin, Debussy and Wagner - into a variety of different early jazz forms for his 7 piece band.
