HOW TO REGISTER

1). The easiest way for a Jazz Lover to register is to do everything on-line (with payment by PayPal). We have also included a complete set of fillable registration forms on our website. Simply download the appropriate form, enter your details and save your changes, and then send the completed form to us by email or post.

WHAT'S ON

THURSDAY 7th JUNE

On Thursday night for early arrivals, we will be having a Jazz Dance at Club Sapphire. Kicking off at 7.30pm, this is an informal off-ticket event and will cost \$10 for badge holders and \$15 for non-badge holders. Just pay at the door.

FRIDAY 8th JUNE

At 5pm the Festival will start in all six venues and finish at midnight.

SATURDAY 9th JUNE

The Festival will again stage the ever popular parade through town. Starting at 10.30am, it will finish at the outdoor stage on Beach Street with the Big Blow and a sing-along.

Immediately afterwards at noon the program will re-start and continue through till midnight.

On Saturday evening Jazz Quest will be held at the Lakeview Hotel. This provides a great opportunity to hear the future trends of jazz and to be amazed at the talent on show from our young musicians.

Immediately afterwards, the jam session 'Bebop and Beyond' will bring together musicians young and old to play right through till 2am.

SUNDAY 10th JUNE

The ecumenical service will be held in St. Joseph's Catholic Church, opposite the RSL on Main St commencing at 11.30am.

At noon the program will recommence in all venues and continue through till midnight.

MONDAY 11th JUNE

The Jazz Hatters Party is a fun-filled day to be held at the RSL and will feature a line up of popular bands. There will be prizes for the best hats and the Festival raffle will also be drawn. It is a community event and is free for all. You cannot bring your own food or drinks but there will be plenty available at a reasonable cost.

Don't forget to take time to see the Jazz Art display at Club Sapphire. One of the paintings will feature as the basis for next year's poster. The 2018 poster is based on the painting by Di Tarrant and the colours for this year, lemon, lime and orange on white are based on those in the painting.

BAND REGISTRATION CLOSING DATE WILL BE 19 MARCH

There is no fee for bands but members must be fully registered.

There is a limited number of spots available and entries received after the closing date cannot be accepted.

Note that band registration must also rely on musicians registering with their

Unregistered musicians will not appear in the program book and will not be eligible for a disbursement.

MUSICIAN REGISTRATION CLOSING DATE 19TH MARCH

Please note that you will not be registered until your form and your fee have both been processed.

Musicians also note that time shown for a private gig includes the time taken to get there and to return.

- The Jazz Hatters Party is at the RSL Club. As noted last year, this indoor event replaces the Jazz Picnic to avoid problems with inclement weather. The Club will run a FREE shuttle bus throughout the day and further details will appear in the Festival program book and on our website.
- Note that alcohol cannot be taken onto club premises and grounds, however there will be ample food and drink available for sale on the day.
