NOTE

- All Band and Musician Registration Forms, including any payments, must be received NO LATER than 12 weeks prior to the festival (22nd March).
- To register as a Musician, you must be in a Registered Band and perform on the Jazz Festival Program.
- The Band Leader **must** complete a Band Registration form (no fee, **BUT THE FORM IS REQUIRED**).
- As there is a limit to the number of performance spots, some Band registrations could be wait-listed.
- Musicians may nominate a **MAXIMUM OF 2 BANDS** for inclusion in the Jazz Festival Program.
NOTE: Only these two nominated bands will be given preference in programming. While you can perform in more than 2 bands, it is your responsibility to avoid conflict and to work within the published schedule.
- It is very important that you contact each of your Band Leaders and advise them of your 2 nominated bands.
- At the Festival, please check with Band Leaders and Stage Managers to make sure that you are correctly listed in the Stage Book.
- If you don't provide your banking details, we will not be able to pay you disbursements (see below).
- Your numbered badge is your receipt. It can be collected from the Jazz Office from the Thursday of the Jazz Festival weekend. You will also receive a Jazz Festival Program.
- **PLEASE** wear your badge throughout the Jazz Festival, it is your ticket to all venues. No badge, no entry! (note: for legal reasons, you must also comply with the entry requirements at the local Clubs).

Disbursements to Musicians and Big Bands

- After the festival, musicians may be eligible for a payment from the proceeds of the festival (**disbursement**).
- Individual disbursements are generally paid to musicians on a sliding scale, corresponding to the distance travelled to get to the festival.
- Lump-sum disbursements are generally paid to the Leader of each Big Band.
- Musicians who play only in Big Bands are not eligible for an individual disbursement.
- Payments will only be made via direct deposit into a valid bank or financial institution account, as nominated by you on Page 1 of this form.
(For Big Bands, only the Band Leader is required to list account details).
- Please provide accurate and clear account details to ensure payment.
- **Musicians and Big Band Leaders who do not provide banking details will not receive a disbursement.**
